

ORDER

1. Citation and commencement - This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Import) Amendment Order (No.1) 2018 and commences on 1 April 2017.

2. Interpretation – In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears, “Principal Order” means the Order of Prohibited Imports 2008.

3. New Order 2E, 2F and 2G inserted – After Order 2D of the Principal Order, insert—

“2E. A left-hand drive vehicle is exempted from the prohibition under Order 2(ii) if the left hand drive vehicle imported into Samoa is:

- (i) a pickup truck or 6 wheel truck;
- (ii) is imported by an individual; and

(iii) will not be used for the purposes of providing taxi and bus services.

2F. Left hand drive vehicles imported into Samoa which are exempted under Order 2E must not:

- (i) exceed 100 vehicles per month; and
- (ii) must not be imported by any car dealer company with the intention for such vehicles to be sold.

2G. The exemption provided for vehicles under Orders 2E and 2F does not apply to vehicles that are exempted under Orders 2A to 2D.”
