PURSUANT to section 91(3) of the Customs Act 2014, I, **TIALAVEA FEA LENIU TIONISIO HUNT**, Minister for Revenue, acting on the advice of the Comptroller of Customs, **MAKE** the following Order:

ORDER

1. Citation and commencement - This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibited Import) Amendment Order (No.3) 2018 and commences on the date it is signed by the Minister.

2. Interpretation – In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears, “Principal Order” means the Order of Prohibited Imports 2008.

3. Order 2H substituted – In order 2H of the Principal Order substitute with:

“2H. A right or left hand drive vehicle manufactured more than 10 years prior to the date it enters Samoa, is exempt from prohibition where:

- (i) it is personally owned by a Samoan citizen returning to Samoa from seasonal employment or for permanent residency; and
- (ii) the vehicle has been used within 12 months before the date it enters Samoa by a returning Samoan citizen; and
- (iii) the Minister determines an application by a returning Samoan citizen, in accordance with this Order and requirements set by the Comptroller; and
- (iv) the returning Samoan citizen is only allowed one vehicle to be exempted.”

4. Validation - Any vehicle imported before the commencement of this Order may be granted exemption under this Order subject to:

- (a) the requirements of this Order; and
 - (b) if such vehicle is within a Customs Controlled Area.
