**PROHIBITED IMPORTS (AMENDMENT) ORDER (No 2) 2010**  
**- SECTION 49, CUSTOMS ACT 1977**

I, TUI ATUA TUPUA TAMASESE EFI, Head of State of the Independent State of Samoa, acting on the advice of Cabinet and pursuant to section 49 of the Customs Act 1977, hereby ORDER that:

1. The Order of Prohibited Imports 2008 dated 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2008 is amended by inserting after Order 2C:  

“2D A vehicle may be exempt from prohibition where it is a private specialty vehicle determined by the Minister to be of national importance.”
2. This Amendment Order comes into effect on the date it is made.
