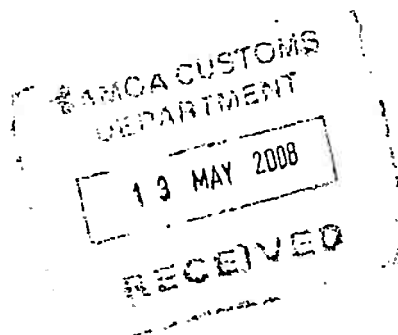

**ORDER OF PROHIBITED IMPORTS – SECTION 49,
CUSTOMS ACT 1977**

I, TUI ATUA TUPUA TAMASESE EFI, Head of State of the Independent State of Samoa, acting on the advice of Cabinet and pursuant to section 49 of the Customs Act 1977, **ORDER** that:

1. The Notice of Prohibited Imports dated the 18th day of January 2008 is repealed.
2. It is unlawful to import into Samoa the following:
 - (i) any vehicle which was manufactured more than 12 years prior to the date on which such vehicle enters Samoa; and
 - (ii) any left-hand drive vehicle being any vehicle having the steering column to the left of the longitudinal centre line.
3. This Order does not apply to any left-hand drive vehicle that:
 - (i) has already been shipped to Samoa; or
 - (ii) has been purchased or ordered for the purposes of shipping to Samoa, and arriving at the ports of Samoa within one (1) month after the date of this Notice.
4. This Order comes into effect on the date it is made.
